annual campaign which is held throughout October aims to teach primary school pupils about the correct use of 999, what happens when you call, and life saving skills including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and how to use a defibrillator.

Led by the Patient Experience and Community Involvement (PECI) team, volunteers across



the Trust, local health board colleagues and medical students give up their free time to visit schools across Wales.

In 2022, the team taught more than 1,800 pupils in 32 different schools the appropriateness of 999, the five emergency services available and life-saving skills; recovery position, hands-only CPR and using a defibrillator.

This year it is anticipated that over 6,000 pupils across 75 schools will be taught these vital life saving skills.



**Inhaler Recycling Scheme** 






