




CHICKENS IN NEED!

Shirenewton Community Council serves the communities of Shirenewton, Mynyddbach, Earlswood and Newchurch West. Due to a change in circumstances, we are re-advertising for a new Council Clerk / RFO to deliver the Council's priorities and statutory requirements.

The Clerk will be both the 'Proper Officer' and 'Responsible Financial Officer' of the Community Council, responsible for executing its legal, financial and administrative requirements. The Clerk will administer the Community Council's affairs and act as representative of the Council in relation to a range of local bodies and organisations including officers and councillors of Monmouthshire County Council and outside contractors.

The person we're looking for will be an excellent communicator both in speech and writing and will be a well organised and flexible problem solver. The duties of Community Council Clerk / RFO involve mainly working from home and also require attendance at monthly evening and occasionally daytime meetings.

This is a part-time post of 15 hours per week, the salary range is £22,369 to £26,845, pro rata, LC1 (SCP 7-17) on the NJC pay scales 2022-23. The appointment will be made subject to satisfactory references and probation period.
