Andy Goldsworthy is a British artist who creates art from nature. He uses sticks and stones to make spirals or circles.

Create a circle or spiral piece of art using only sticks and stones.



Autumn Challenge Card

Symmetry in Nature

Collect different natural objects and create a symmetrical work of art.



Shapes

Collect nine sticks or twigs of approximately the same length. How many different shapes can you make from them?



Autumn Challenge Card

Triangles

Collect nine sticks or twigs of approximately the same length. How many triangles can you make? The current record is 40!



Autumn Challenge Card

Guess the Leaf

Collect 10 different leaves.

Work with a partner and take turns to cover your eyes and feel a leaf. Put the leaf back in the pile and see if you can guess the leaf you touched.

Autumn Challenge Card

Guess the Twig

Collect 10 different twigs.

Work with a partner and take turns to cover your eyes and feel a twig. Put the twig back in the pile and see if you can guess the twig you touched.

Leaf Sort

Collect 10 different leaves. Work with a partner to sort your leaves into different categories. You could sort by shapes, colours, sizes or any other criteria.

How many different ways can you sort them?

Use chalk and create a bar chart.

Autumn Challenge Card

Make a Den

Use a selection of sticks and twigs to make a den for a small toy.

Can you make your den waterproof?

Can you build rooms in your den?

Can you make any pieces of furniture?



Autumn Challenge Card

Bird's Nest

Working with a partner, make a bird's nest using only natural materials. You are both only allowed to use one arm as a bird only uses its beak!



Autumn Challenge Card

Class Quilt

Using twigs, divide a section of the playground into squares like a patchwork quilt. Give each child a square to create a piece of artwork using items they collect in the playground.

Autumn Alphabet


Collect different leaves, twigs, sticks and stones and create the letters of the alphabet.

As a follow-up, ask the children to think of a word related to autumn for each letter.
