Spring Special Mission 2023



Early findings from our Ambitions for Wales survey, completed in 2022, told us that 61% of children aged 7-11 and 52% of children aged 12-18 worried about their families not having enough

money for the things they need.

We know that you will be acutely aware of the challenges facing the families in your community,

and we know that so many schools and individual teachers across Wales are going above and

beyond to help children and parents during this incredibly difficult time.

For the Spring Special Mission, we have updated our Charter for Change resources to help school

staff and pupils to work together to consider the broad range of costs associated with the school

day.

Ceri is a fictional character who represents a child or young person whose family don't always

have enough money to afford the things they need, and who may miss out on their rights.

This resource is designed to help pupils and staff to think about what costs might be difficult for
